We plan to serve food from the Western Coast of India which would include Keralite, Mangalorean, Goanese and Konkaneese cuisines and a few items from the small villages along the coast. It will be the third restaurant of the Club which will be entirely managed by our Staff. We are planning for a soft opening where 20 seats will be available to start with, out of possible 30 seats. No take away facility will be available for the first 3 months.

We also want to use the place as a gallery for young artists to showcase their work, which are created using different media and platforms. The paintings will be up for sale with numbers attached. If you like any particular work you may contact our restaurant reception and can get the name and the phone number of the artist concerned. You can then directly get in touch with the artist and show your interest about that painting. This is a humble effort on our part to encourage young talents.

The booking will open from 18th March and for a few initial days, you need to contact our Steward's office either directly or via main Reception. Also, do watch out for a few colorful mailers where you can see some of the food items.
